The Context of the Account of Rehoboam and his reign in the Chronicles of the Kings led me to insert this 3 year period before the division of the Kingdom. This affects the traditional date of the Babylonian Captivity starting from 586bc to 538bc. It also places the decree of Cyrus 3 years later and reconciles the 430 years of Ezekiel, and the seventy years of Jeremiah as well as the 483 year period in Daniels 70 weeks to the Start of Christ's Ministry. Although Rehoboam took over the Kingdom at the death of Solomon, he went to Shechem and his reign begins in Jerusalem upon his return. Israel abandoned him and Jeroboam began his reign.

As Some date the 430 year Sojourn erroneously from this point in time. Eg Archbishop Usher and the Rabbi's . See Psalm 105:10 , Gal 3:17 .
- C62: **D.H.Hume:**
This period is occurs within the 10 years to Sarai having given Abraham her handmaid Hagar to wife, the breakdown of the Egyptian Period of 7 years is taken from a fragment in the dead sea scrolls in english by G. Vermes.

- I73: Eastons Dictionary: **Moriah**
The chosen of Jehovah. Some contend that Mount Gerizim is meant, but most probably we are to regard this as one of the hills of Jerusalem. Here Solomon's temple was built, on the spot that had been the threshing-floor of Ornan the Jebusite #2Sa 24:24,25 2Ch 3:1 It is usually included in Zion, to the north-east of which it lay, and from which it was separated by the Tyropoean valley. This was "the land of Moriah" to which Abraham went to offer up his son Isaac #Ge 22:2 It has been supposed that the highest point of the temple hill, which is now covered by the Muslim Kubbetes-Sakhrah, or "Dome of the Rock, " is the actual site of Araunah's threshing-floor. - C75: **Josephus:** Now they had brought with them everything necessary for a sacrifice excepting the animal that was to be offered only. Now Isaac was twenty-five years old. And as he was building the altar, he asked his father what he was about to offer, since there was no animal there for an oblation: to which it was answered, "That God would provide himself an oblation, he being able to make a plentiful provision for men out of what they have not, and to deprive others of what they already have, when they put too much trust therein; that, therefore, if God pleased to be present and propitious at this sacrifice, he would provide himself an oblation."
- E84: **D. H.Hume:**
Because Issacs death seemed imminent to Esau , Jacob obeyed his mother . Although Isaac only died after Jacob returned to his father with his wives and family , after being reconciled to Esau. This date has to be derived from Joseph's birth and Jacobs entry into Egypt.
- C96: **D.H.Hume: Animal Livestock bring forth their young once a year, therefore for each year of service the wages were changed. Jacobs wages being a certain portion of the natural increase in the livestock.**
- F97: Josephus:According to Josephus, the Book contains a period of 2883 years; Scripture Chronology, however, fixes it at 2288 years, viz.,

- A100: **D. H.Hume: this infers that the next year when Joseph is 31 will be a year of plenty.**
- A104: **D .H.Hume:**
Ga 3:17 And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect. Effectively Christ Confirmed the promised Covenant at the Last Supper. The first Passover celebrated after the 430 years that introduced the first Law does not annul the promise but confirms it and fulfills its very purpose. A type of Christ slain upon a blood marked wooden doorframe doorframe points to this. As well as the Ram hanging in thicket at the time the promise was made. Joh 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.
Ex 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. Ga 3:8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.
- I106: **Barry Setterfield:** Excerpt From "CREATION AND CATASTROPHE CHRONOLOGY"
God appeared to Jacob on six occasions. God's sixth and final appearance to Jacob is recorded in Genesis 46:2-4, just as Israel was setting out from Canaan to go into Egypt. There the Egyptian Sojourn was confirmed, as was the making of a great nation, which would afterwards return to the Promised Land that Jacob was leaving. This was the same as God's original Promise to Abraham. Consequently, this was the required confirmation of that Promise to Jacob (Israel). The Galatian text states that this confirmation was given 430 years before the reception of the Law at Sinai, just after the Exodus. On this basis, the Sojourn indeed lasts 430 years exactly. God's statement to Abraham, the plain record of Moses, and Paul's Galatian comments are then in entire harmony.
- A112: **Barry Setterfield:** Excerpt From "CREATION AND CATASTROPHE CHRONOLOGY"
With the observational verification of the Canaan Entry date we turn to the Egyptian Sojourn. Moses stated in Exodus 12:40-41 that the Exodus occurred 430 years to the very day that Jacob (Israel) and his family came into Egypt. This accords well with Genesis 15:13 where the LORD told Abraham that his descendants would be afflicted in Egypt for 400 years. This was reiterated in Acts 7:6, so the Old Testament and New Testament comments are completely in accord. Indeed, as is shown below, the Church Fathers totally supported Moses' statement that a full 430 years were spent in Egypt. Time-wise, this meant that a political change of climate began 39 years after Joseph was made Prime Minister, and 41 years before he died at 110.
- F116: **D.H.Hume:**
Levi's Death is a link between Genesis and Exodus . Because Moses was a direct descendant of Levi therefore he would be aware of the timeframes. Joseph's birth presents some difficulties and can only be reconciled to the entry of Jacob into Egypt in the second year of the Famine. Jacob's servitude under Laban has to be calculated because there is no absolute reference to it.

The BC Starting Date is reconciled to Christ announcing the Acceptable year of the Lord in Ad 26-27. The tradional Date of Christ's Crucifixion is AD 30, as opposed to the Ad 33 view. See the note by David Chilton on the birth of Christ. So 1524+26=1550 which gives us the thirtieth 50 year Jubilee ,The first celebrated in the promised land.

Forty years later The Romans invaded Judea AD 66. The Exodus of the New Covenant Israel ocured at this point in time. To conquer the world with Christ's Redeeming Love.

Calculation formula to ensure that length of reigns are inclusive of the first and last year. EG. G4 =D4+F4-1 where D4 is the length ,F4 is the start and G4 the end. The BC Period being correlated the same way and adjusted for the non existant year 0AD, using the fixed constant for the beginning of months.
- C140: Josephus: 29. (117) So Joshua, when he had thus discoursed to them, died, having lived a hundred and ten years; {k} forty of which he lived with Moses, in order to learn what might be for his advantage afterward. He also became their commander after Moses' death for twenty-five years.
D.H.Hume: Because I could not prove Josephus's assertion , in order to reconcile Jephthah's 300 years , I reduced the length to 15 Years. Five of which are aligned to Joshua and Caleb's return at Kadesh Barnea and the balance covering the period to Joshua's death. (There is no record of Joshua's birth or age at the exodus, that I could find) I have calculated it.
- A144: **D H Hume:**
Because this is an abnormally long period of rulership. I have split the length between Ehud and Shamgar giving them forty years a piece. This follows the leadership example of Moses, and Joshua's Covenant in Shechem.
- C152: **D H Hume:**
This Section of Judges differs from the preceeding ones in that combined they exceed the the forty years that so frequently appear amongst the Judges. This suggest a Break in the 40th year Covenant renewal that Joshua legislated. The Period from Jephthah to Samuel brings the total to 79 ,there is a possibility of a year between the time Jephthah stood up when the other tribes requested his leadership and the King of Ammon rejected his warning. This would allow an overlap in Eli's Judgeship. Taking this into consideration I have started Eli's Judgeship in the year Samson Died. And started Jephthah's reign a year later. Either way the result is the same.
- I155: D. H.Hume
This Event occurred in the year following the death of Aaron , When Eleazar was appointed High Priest (Num 20:27/28)
- C162: **D H Hume:**
This Second period following Samsons first period covers the Philistine period of Forty years. It is unusual to find a double reference to the same period.
- A164: Eastons Dictionary Eli
1. Ascent, the high priest when the ark was at Shiloh #1Sa 1:3,9 He was the first of the line of Ithamar, Aaron's fourth son #1Ch 24:3 comp. #2Sa 8:17 who held that office. The office remained in his family till the time of Abiathar #1Ki 2:26,27 whom Solomon deposed, and appointed Zadok, of the family of Eleazar, in his stead #1Ki 2:35. He acted also as a civil judge in Israel after the death of Samson #1Sa 4:18
- F164: **D H Hume:**
By reconciling Jephthah's 300 years , the 450 years in Paul's discourse ends at Eli judgeship and Samuel Follows eg: "four hundred and fifty years, until Samuel the prophet"

- A170: **D.H.Hume:**
Using the reference in acts Chap 13, I have taken the 40 years as being the period of the last Judge of Israel who in his life span anointed two Kings and followed Eli, whose sons were killed. The only reference in the divine canon of Sauls reign is the three year reference. The Kingdom was rent from him and David was anointed by Samuel, and his reign is started following Sauls son.
- F172: D.H.Hume:
Josephus Ascribes 20 years to the reign of Saul , which would be under the Supervision of Samuel, until David was anointed by Samuel, after Saul rent Samuels Garment and lost the Kingdom. Else where Josephus tallys it to 22 years which include Sauls Son. See the Reconciliation in my Summary of the Kings, Josephus's 514 years of the Kings of Judah.
- A174: Colin Heath
NB: The reigns of David and his son Solomon overlapped. Solomon was crowned early because of the threat of David's son Adonijah, 1Kings 1:5-48. The 4th year of Solomon's reign mentioned in 1Kings 6:1 marked the completion of the 40 years of King David. Colin-Heath@bibleinsight.com
- I182: D H Hume:
The Context of the Account of Rehoboam and his reign in the Chronicles of the Kings led me to insert this 3 year period before the division of the Kingdom. This affects the traditional date of the Babylonian Captivity starting from 586bc to 583bc. It also places the decree of Cyrus 3 years later and reconciles the 430 years of Ezekiel, and the seventy years of Jeremiah as well as the 483 year period in Daniels 70 weeks to the Start of Christ's Ministry. Although Rehoboam took over the Kingdom at the death of Solomon , he went to Shechem and his reign begins in Jerusalem upon his return. Israel abandoned him and Jeroboam began his reign.

There was an interregnum from some unknown cause between the reign of Jeroboam and the accession of his son, which lasted, according to some, for ten or twelve years, according to others, for twenty-two years, or more. This prince pursued the religious policy of the calf-worship, and his reign was short, being abruptly terminated by the hand of violence. In his fate was fulfilled the prophecy addressed to Jehu (#2Ki 10:30; also #Ho 1:4), that his family would possess the throne of Israel for four generations; and accordingly Jehoahaz, Joash, Jehoram, and Zechariah were his successors—but there his dynasty terminated; and perhaps it was the public knowledge of this prediction that prompted the murderous design of Shallum.

The Last three years of Zedekiah are in rebellion to the Prophet Jeremiah and the Lords Appointed Sovereign Nebuchadnessar

Zedekiah rebelled against Nebuchadnessar and the reign returns to Jehoichin after his third year in power thus 3+37 years of Jehoichin reign in captivity account for the forty years of Judahs rebellion the 390 years have been fulfilled at that point. Rulership over the Royal Grant is Re-established. When his throne is put above all the Kings of the nations in Captivity. Thus he became the supreme vice regent.
- I255: Mathew Poole's Commentary
Neither shall it be inhabited forty years: accounting these years from the first wastings of Egypt by their civil dissensions and wars, some nine or ten years before Nebuchadnezzar subdued and wasted it, which he did in the thirty-fifth, thirty-sixth, and thirty-seventh years of his reign, or thereabout. So that these forty years will fall in about the **thirtieth year of Jeconiah's captivity**, and end with the seventieth year of the captivity, which was the first of Cyrus. - I265: **David Chilton (Days of Vengeance)** : The key is the Moon. The apostle said it was located 'under her feet.' What does the word 'under' signify in this case? Does it mean the Woman of the vision was standing on the Moon when John observed it or does it mean her feet were positioned slightly above the Moon? John does not tell us. This, however, is not of major consequence in using the Moon to answer our question because it would only involve the difference of a degree or two. Since the feet of Virgo the Virgin represent the last 7 degrees of the constellation (in the time of Christ this would have been between about 180 and 187 degrees along the ecliptic), the Moon has to be positioned somewhere under that 7-degree arc. C., was the beginning of Tishri 1 in the Jewish calendar – Rosh Hashanah, the Day of Trumpets!
- D269: **D. H.Hume:**
A Second Adar (Extra Month) added in to bring the Lunar Calendar into line with the Seasons.
- A278: Josephus War of the Jews Book 6 Chapter 5 section 3. (288) Thus were the miserable people persuaded by these deceivers, and such as belied God himself; while they did not attend nor give credit to the signs that were so evident, and did so plainly foretell their future desolation; but, like men infatuated, without either eyes to see or minds to consider, did not regard the denunciations that God made to them. (289) Thus there was a star {d} resembling a sword, which stood over the city, and a comet, that continued a whole year. (290) Thus also, before the Jews' rebellion, and before those commotions which preceded the war, when the people were come in great crowds to the feast of unleavened bread, on the eighth day of the month of Xanthikos {e} [Nisan], (Niese: April 25, Capellus: April 8) and at the ninth hour of the night, so great a light shone around the altar and the holy house, that it appeared to be bright daytime; which lasted for half an hour. (291) This light seemed to be a good sign to the unskilful, but was so interpreted by the sacred scribes as to portend those events that followed immediately upon it. (292) At the same festival also, a heifer, as she was led by the high priest to be sacrificed, brought forth a lamb in the midst of the temple. (293) Moreover, the eastern gate of the inner [court of the] temple, which was of brass, and extremely heavy, and had been with difficulty shut by twenty men, and fastened with iron-bound bars, and had bolts sunk very deep into the firm floor, which was there made of one entire stone, was seen to be opened of its own accord about the sixth hour of the night.(294) Now, those who kept watch in the temple, came hereupon running to the captain of the temple, and told him of it; who then came up there, and not without great difficulty was able to shut the gate again. (295) This also appeared to the common people to be a very happy prodigy, as if God thereby opened to them the gate of happiness. But the men of learning understood it, that the security of their holy house was dissolved of its own accord, and that the gate was opened for the advantage of their enemies. (296) So these publicly declared that the signal predicted the desolation that was coming upon them. Besides these, a few days after that feast, on the twenty-first day of the month of Artemisios [Iyyar], (Niese: June 8, Capellus: May 21) (297) a certain prodigious and incredible phenomenon appeared: I suppose the account of it would seem to be a fable, were it not related by those who saw it, (298) and were not the events that followed it of so considerable a nature as to deserve such signals; for, before sunset, chariots and troops of soldiers in their armour were seen (299) running about among the clouds, and surrounding the cities. Moreover, at that feast which we call Pentecost, as the priests were going by night into the inner {f} [court of the] temple, as their custom was, to perform their sacred ministrations, they said that, in the first place, **they felt a quaking, and heard a great noise, (300) and after that they heard a sound as of a great multitude, saying, "We are departing from here."**
- A279: Wikipedia:
The Jewish sage Rabbi Akiva (alternatively Akiba) regarded the chosen commander Simon Bar Kokhba to be the Jewish Messiah, according to the Star Prophecy verse from Numbers 24:17: "There shall come a star out of Jacob" [3] ("Bar Kokhba" means "son of a star" in the Aramaic language).

D H Hume: This Section of Judges differs from the preceding ones in that combined they exceed the forty years that so frequently appear amongst the Judges. This suggest a Break in the 40th year Covenant renewal that Joshua legislated. The Period from Jephthah to Samuel brings the total to 79, there is a possibility of a year between the time Jephthah stood up when the other tribes requested his leadership and the King of Ammon rejected his warning. This would allow an overlap in Eli's judgeship. Taking this into consideration I have started Eli's Judgeship in the year Samson Died. And started Jephthah's reign a year later. Either way the result is the same.
